The regulation of the Mirzo Ulugbek International Olympiad on Physics and Astronomy among 10-11^{the} grade-pupils of the high schools

This regulation determines an order of the organization and carrying out, also an order of definition of winners of the international Olympiad by a name of the great thinker and astronomer Mirzo Ulugbek on physics and astronomy (further – the Olympiad) among 10-11th grade-pupils of high schools.

I. General rules

- 1. Main objectives of holding the international Olympiad are:
- promoting broadly a huge contribution of our great ancestors to development of a world civilization at the international level;
- educating the youth, worthy our great ancestors;
- creating friendly competing environment for our talented pupils with the peers from foreign countries, strengthening their skills through successful participation at the international Olympiad;
- showing talent and creative abilities of student at the international level;
- Increasing interest of pupils in deep studying physics and astronomy.
- 2. The objects of the International Olympiads are:
- ensuring development of teaching and educational process in educational institutions at the level of modern requirements, increasing pedagogical skill of subject teachers, identifying talented and gifted pupils;
- encouraging talented and gifted pupils and supporting their knowledge on the international scene;
- Promoting the success of pupils achieved at the international Olympiad among foreign peers.

II. The order of holding the Olympiad

- 3. The international Olympiad is held once in two years among 10-11th grade pupils of high schools.
- 4. There are two stages of every subject (physics and astronomy) of the international Olympiad:

1^{st} stage – theoretical
```

2nd stage – experimental

- 5. There are six students (three of them in physics and three of them in astronomy) and two group leaders can participate in the international Olympiad.
- 6. The expenses of organizing and holding the international Olympiad go from means of the approved budget part "Ta'lim" of the Ministry of Public education for the corresponding year, expenses of international participants of the Olympiad go at the expense of the country –sender.
- 7. Winners of the international Olympic Games are determined by subjects (physics, astronomy) separately.
- 8. The share of winners in each subject makes 50% of participation.
- 9. The winners of The International Olympiad are awarded with golden, silver medals and corresponding diploma.
- 10. The quantity of prizes will be distributed on levels in the ratio 1:2:3.
- 11. Responsibility for the organization and holding the international Olympiad is assigned to the Ministry of Public Education.
- 12. In order to fulfill the complex of all actions in conducting the International Olympiad, the organizing committee in the appropriate order is formed.
- 13. The organizing committee provides preparation for the international Olympiad and carrying out it with unique scientific and methodical approach, forms and approves the structure of jury and the appeal commission, prepares tasks of the Olympiad in the Uzbek, Russian and English languages, observes the translation by heads of commands into the language, working confidentially, approves criteria of estimates and summing up.

- 14. The ministry of public education establishes the plan of measures of holding the international Olympiad by the established criteria at all levels and its openness.
- 15. The jury of the Olympic Games checks compliance of tasks for all stages with the international requirements and provides complexity with the required level.
- 16. Works of participants and winners of the international Olympic Games aren't shown to heads of other teams, participants and their parents.
- 17. The participants who have broken an established order of holding international Olympiad are discharged by the order of jury. The statement drawn up by judges will be signed by the chairman.
- 18. Winners of the international Olympiad from Uzbekistan will receive a privilege for becoming student at universities and institutes without exams on the basis of the order of the Cabinet Ministers of the Republic of Uzbekistan No. 226 "About rewarding and material encouragement of gifted youth of Uzbekistan" from October 13, 2008.

III. The Jury.

- 19 For carrying out all stages of the international Olympiad on every subject jury will be formed in number of 5-7 people and will be approved by organizing committee.
- 20 The judges formed for each subject elect the chairman of jury among them.
- 21. Juries carry out the following tasks:
- a) Check the works on the established criteria performed by pupils and estimate together with heads of teams;
- b) Determine winners of the international Olympiad by subjects;
- c) Prepare the text of the order on the end of the international Olympiad in accordance with the established procedure and make out it;
- d) Announce results of the international Olympiad in presence of participants and heads of teams;
- e) Give all the particulars to organizing committee about results of the international Olympiad and provide necessary documents.

IV. Heads of audiences and observers

- 22. For management of all stages of holding the international Olympiad, for performance of organizational affairs, for ensuring justice, the organizing committee by means of drawing establishes heads of audiences and observers for rooms where stages of the international Olympic Games will be held.
- 23. Heads of audiences carry out the following tasks:
- a) Acquaint judges with documents on the Olympic Games on this subject;
- b) draw up the statement of the pupils who have broken an established order of process of the international Olympiad, discharge them from process of the Olympiad, present the act to organizing committee;
- c) put the cipher at works of participants and present them to judges for checking;
- d) Make the list of the ciphered works checked by judges and provide it to organizing committee for definition of winners.

V. Rewarding the winners of the International Olympiad.

24. The winners and the prizewinners of the International Olympiad are awarded with golden, silver, bronze medals with diploma, as well as some valuable souvenirs.

VI. Appeal commission.

- 25. The appeal commission is formed from one specialist in a subject who hasn't been a part of jury.
- 26. The chairman of organizing committee directly is the chairman of the appeal commission.
- 27. Protests are accepted within three hours after announcement of preliminary results to heads of teams.
- 28. The protest of the head of team is considered by the member of the appeal commission in the presence of the chairman of the appeal commission and judges.
- 29. The appeal commission if necessary has the right to count the order of jury invalid and to make changes to it.

VII. Final rules.

30. The persons which have violated rules of this regulation bear responsibility on an established order in the law.
