JAPANESE GOVERNMENT (MEXT) SCHOLARSHIP FOR 2019 (THAILAND) — SPECIALIZED TRAINING COLLEGE STUDENTS —

Additional to the Application Guidelines, the details of the selection and some special requirements are set by the Embassy of Japan in Thailand as following. **Please read carefully before submitting the application.**

1. QUALIFICATION

Applicants must have the **cumulative grade point average (GPA) 3.00 or more** at an upper secondary school.

2. APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCEDURES IN THAILAND

The Embassy of Japan in Thailand will conduct the First Screening of applicants by means of review of the submitted documents, written examinations and interviews.
