## 1. QUALIFICATION

- (1) Applicants must have Thai nationality.
- (2) Applicants must have attained a <u>cumulative GPA of at least 3.00</u> on a 4.00 GPA scale at an upper secondary school.

## 2. APPLICATION AND SELECTION PROCEDURES IN THAILAND

The Embassy of Japan in Thailand will conduct the First Screening of applicants by means of screening the submitted application documents, written examination and interview. The decision on successful candidates made by the Embassy of Japan is final and the reasons will not be disclosed. Any queries on the final decision will not be entertained.

- 1. These documents must be written in English or Japanese, or translation in either of these languages should be attached.
- 2. Please submit the above list of application documents even though this list is different from the list written in the application guidelines. The Embassy of Japan does <u>not request to submit Recommendation Letter and Medical Certificate at the time of application.</u> Applicants will be requested to submit after have passed the first screening.
- 3. Your application may be rejected if the above application is incomplete, or if some documents are missing.
- 4. The submitted **documents will not be returned**.
- 5. Applicants must <u>circle</u> <u>one</u> of the examination venues (Bangkok, Chiang Mai, Khon Kaen, Songkhla) <u>on the Admission Form.</u>
- 6. Applicants must submit the above documents **by post** to the Bureau of International Cooperation, Ministry of Education **by Friday, 24 May 2024**. Hand or messenger delivered documents will not be accepted.
