 - 3) Instituting the new Buddhist sect of Thamayut, characterized by strict monastic discipline.
 - 4) The pursuit of freedom of religion for all.
 - 5) His archaeological interest and endeavour leading to the discovery and renovation of Phraphathom Chedi and also the discovery of King Ramkhamhaeng's stone slab as well as two Sukhothai pillars with inscriptions.
 - 6) His achievement in laying the foundations for introducing modern science into the country.
 - 7) His achievement in mastering languages, mathematics, and astronomy.
 - 8) His practical innovations, including printing Press and the publishing of the Royal Gazette.
